In this capacity, Santulli oversees the Building Enforcement Safety Team/Site Safety, Cranes & Derricks, Excavations & Interior Demolitions, Scaffolds & Sheds; and Stop Work Order units.

Prior to this new appointment, Santulli was Buildings' Manhattan Borough Commissioner (2006 – 2008) and Deputy Manhattan Borough Commissioner (2003 – 2006). During this time, Santulli utilized his diverse background in consulting and change management to catalyze the Commissioner's reforms and improve the borough office's procedures and processes.
