NEW 2018 Safety Training Requirements in New York City

One of the major provisions of the New York City Site Safety Training Law (NYC SST), also referred to as [Local Law 196](#), requires any online training taken **after October 16, 2017** to be **actively proctored**. It is specifically targeted at workers who perform construction and demolition activities within NYC borough jurisdictions.

ClickSafety's Voice Authentication on our OSHA 10-Hour Construction and OSHA 30-Hour Construction courses has been accepted by New York Department of Buildings to comply with the actively proctored online training requirements of New York City Site Safety Training Local Law 196. **The voice-authenticated courses shown below comply with the NYC SST actively proctored requirements in New York City.**

Upon completion, the individual taking the course will receive a specific NY city LL196 course completion certificate. **THIS CERTIFICATE SHOULD BE CARRIED ON-PERSON TO PROVIDE PROOF OF COMPLETED VOICE-AUTHENTICATED TRAINING.**
